
Cahill Continues its Longstanding Dominance in Capital Markets and Lending League Tables with Top Rankings in 1H 2026

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Cahill's Capital Markets and Banking & Finance practices once again secured top positions across the legal adviser league tables published by *Bloomberg*, *Debtwire*, and *LSEG* for the first half of 2026, reinforcing the firm's longstanding leadership in the leveraged finance and high-yield markets. Since 2005, Cahill has maintained a market-leading position in U.S. High Yield Corporate Bonds and U.S. Leveraged Loans.

In the latest league table results, Cahill retained its #1 position as legal adviser in U.S. High Yield Corporate Bonds (capturing nearly 30% of the market), U.S. Leveraged Finance, and U.S. Leveraged Loans in the *Bloomberg* league tables. The firm also ranked #1 in North America High Yield Corporate Bonds (capturing nearly 40% of the market), M&A High Yield Bonds, and Institutional Loans by *Debtwire* and #1 Lender Legal Adviser in Leveraged Finance by *LSEG*.*
