

Court of Appeals Addresses Meaning of “Executives” and “Wages” Under NY Labor Law

A recent New York Court of Appeals decision clarifies two important aspects of New York Labor Law. In *Pachter v. Bernard Hodes Group, Inc.*¹, the appeals court held that executives are entitled to the protections granted to employees in article 6 of the Labor Law and that employers and employees are free to structure a compensation arrangement under which an employee's commissions are "earned" only after deductions are taken from the employee's gross pay.
