
In re Qwest Communications Int'l. Sec. Litigation, No. 06-1070 (10th Cir. June 19, 2006)

On June 19, 2006, the Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit decided *In re Qwest Communications Int'l Securities Litigation*, holding that Qwest waived its attorney-client privilege and nonopinion work-product protection by voluntarily producing documents to the SEC and DOJ in connection with those agencies' investigations, notwithstanding a "loose" confidentiality agreement. Accordingly, private plaintiffs were entitled to receive the documents produced to the SEC and DOJ.
